Phonics

 Phonics is the process of decoding and segmenting in order to read and write.

- We follow Little Wandle Letters and Sounds as our phonics programme. This is a DfE validated scheme.
 - Children will have daily whole class phonic lessons.
- Please check on Tapestry for weekly Home Learning sheets.

Reading

- Your child will read in a group 3 times a week. Their reading level is linked closely to their phonic knowledge, meaning that they should be able to read 90% of the book independently.
- On Day 1 children will focus on decoding and understanding vocabulary. Day 2 will look at prosody and Day 3 will concentrate on comprehension. At the end of the week your child will bring this book home as an eBook.
 - In addition, your child will bring home a sharing book on a Monday. This book is intended for you to read together so please so not worry if they can not read it. Please return this on Friday and please sign and date the reading record book each time you hear your child read.
 - The children are reading a range of texts in school and learning lots of new words in Literacy. Ask them to share their knowledge with you and see if they can remember any of the new vocabulary they have been practicing. You can also support your child by practising handwriting. It would be useful if your child was able to independently write simple sentences about the story they have just read.
