Choose a word from your spelling list and then choose a segment of the web, then write your words in the same colour, becoming smaller and smaller as you get closer to the centre.



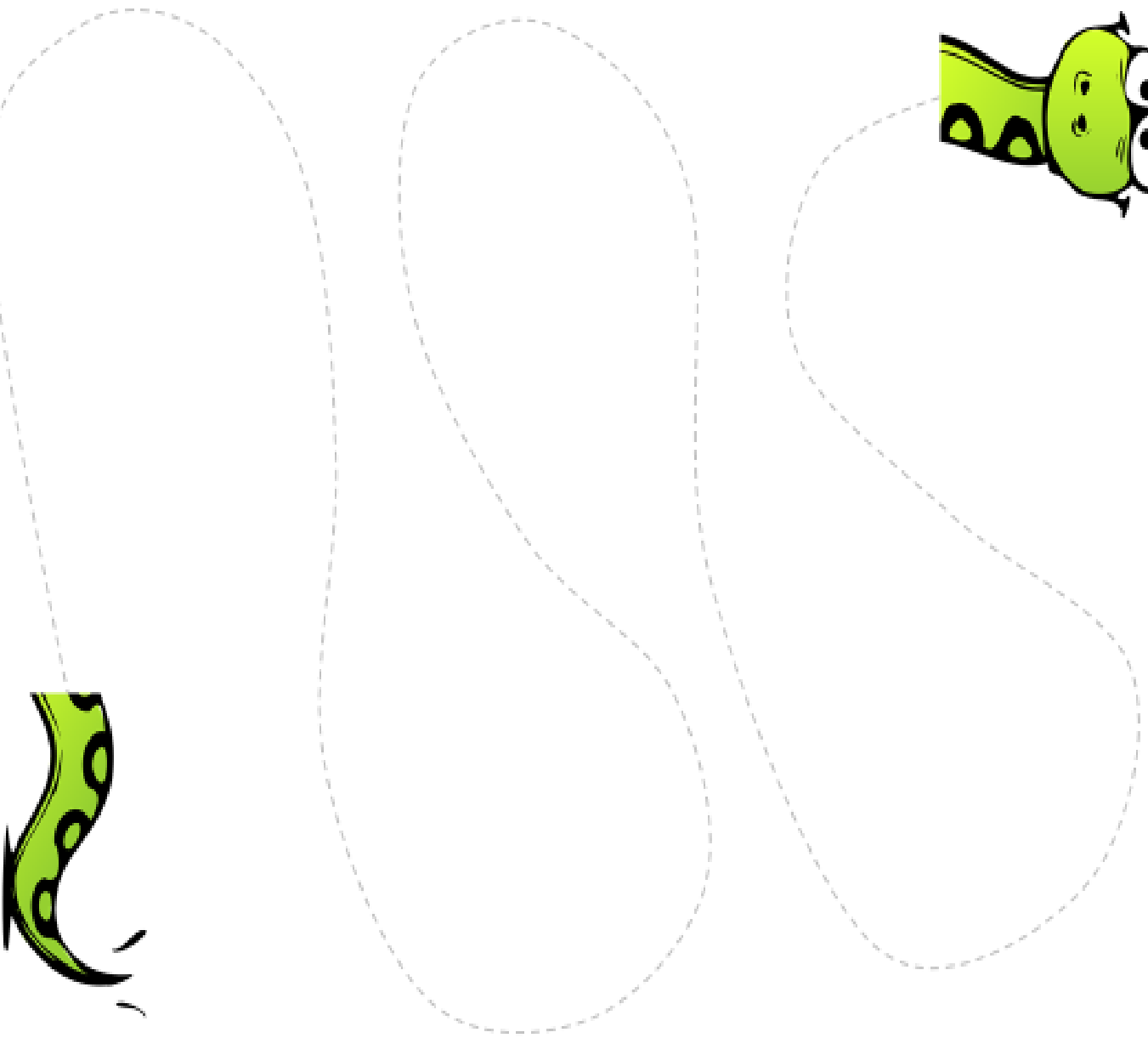
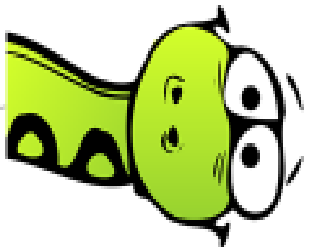

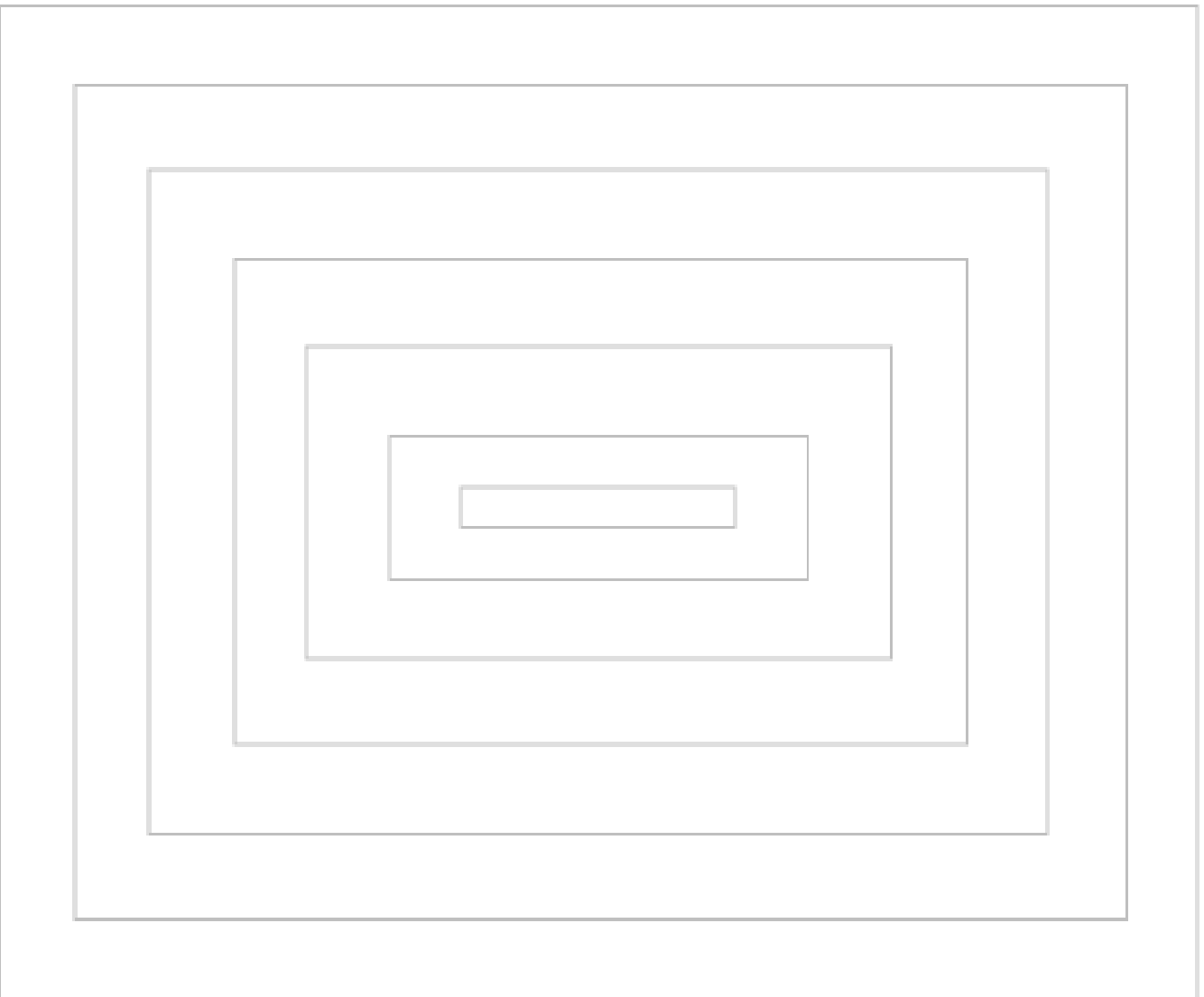
