Dear Parents

What a week! The half term holiday seems like it was much longer than a week ago! I do hope that you were all able to enjoy the holiday. It has been lovely to see all the children back in school and raring to go this week.

Jewellery & Earrings

Staff have noticed this week that there are lots of children wearing necklaces and bracelets into school. Please do ensure that all jewellery is left at home apart from the very obvious health and safety issues it is tragic when a special piece of jewellery is lost or misplaced. We enforce a strict no jewellery rule and we would be grateful for your co-operation in ensuring that the children do not wear any sort of jewellery to school – this includes fabric and woven types.

If your child has pierced ears, earrings should be small, plain silver or gold studs. Glittery, shaped or diamante types are not allowed. They should also be covered with micropore tape when the children have PE.

Water Bottles

Please ensure that your child's water bottle contains nothing but water. These drinks are available to the children at all times during the day and the effect of squash or juice on teeth is dramatic when the children are sipping all day – not to mention very sticky if spilt! Anything but water will be replaced by staff if discovered.

Individual & Sibling Photos

The school photographer will be in school on the 5th & 6th March. All children will have their photograph taken during the school day on the 5th March. For simplicity, the children should wear school uniform for this and this includes hair design and ornamentation.

On the 6th March the photographer will take sibling photographs. Any siblings with us here at school will have photographs taken during the school day. If you wish to have a photograph with a pre-schooler or older child, we will open the school gates for access to the hall at 8am. No children should be left unaccompanied either in the hall or on the playground before staff arrive on the playground at 8.30am.

For simplicity, the children should wear school uniform - not PE kits - on both days. All PE lessons will be adapted accordingly.

Diocesan Building Fund

Currently, less than 40% of our school population have made the donation to the above fund. This has a huge impact on the school budget as we are required to make up the shortfall from our funding in order to support the Diocese. Although we have no projects planned for this year, the school has greatly benefited from this funding in the past – we had the entire school roof replaced just a couple of years ago for example.
