Dear Parents

School Census Day – Thursday 3rd October

Every year the free school meal funding (the amount of money given to the school by the Government to cover the free school meals for YR, 1 & 2) is based upon the number of school meals served on a particular date. We have changed the menu for Thursday it will be Chicken Nuggets & Chips or Veggie Nuggets & Chips; Friday 4th will be Chicken & Tomato Pasta Bake or Quorn Noodle Stir Fry.
